Dear Members of the ChroPac Study Group,

In September 2013, patient recruitment was completed for the ChroPac trial leading into the follow-up phase that will last until September 2015.

By the end of 2014, we were able to close four centres which had finished follow-up and completed their documentation. Still, there are patients in the follow-up phase in nine remaining centres. For these centres it is highly important not to decline with their effort to improve the completeness of documentation as well as to schedule the open visits for their patients.

Currently, the second task is the collection of blood and tissue samples in order to start with the translational research part in January 2015. Therefore you are already in contact with our project management.

We thank all participating centres for their great work.

Finally, we wish you a restful holiday and a healthy start in the New Year 2015.

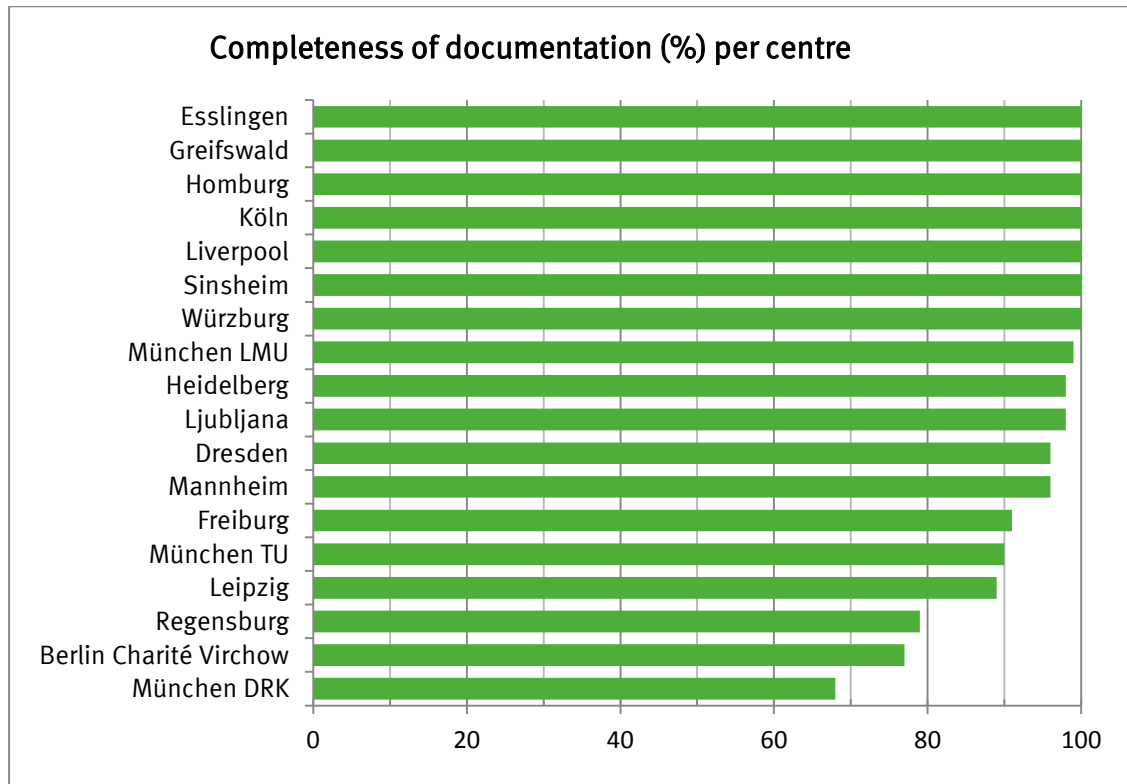
