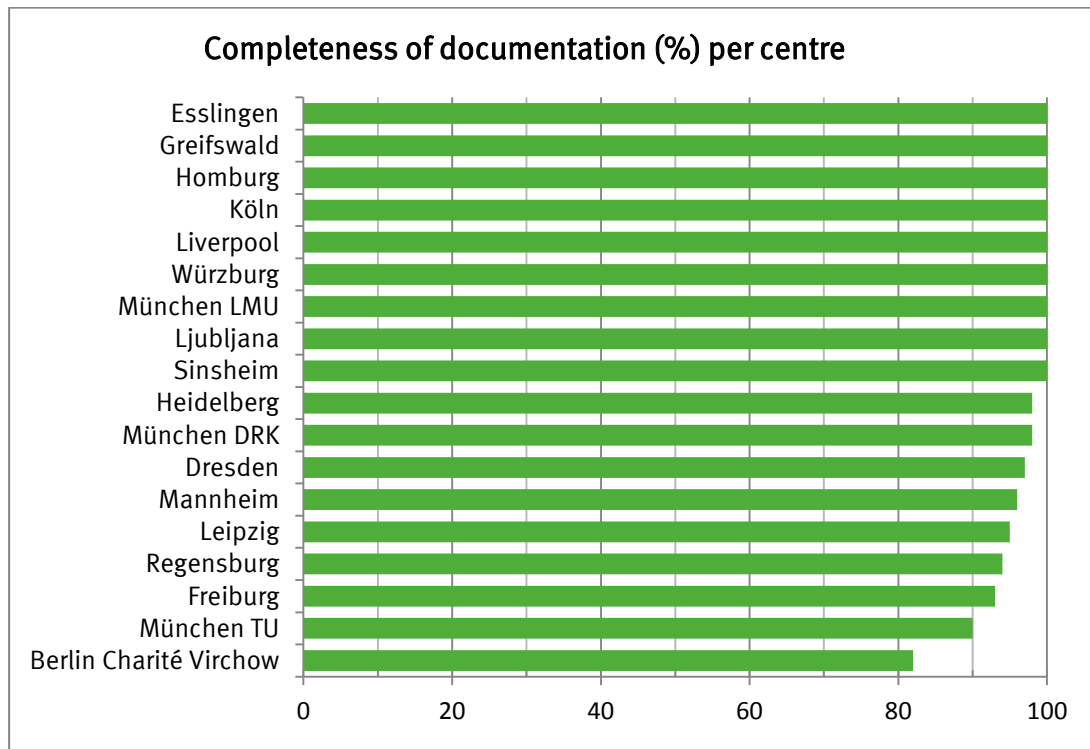
Close Out - Visits
